MISSION REAFFIRMED-STRATEGIC FOCUS SHARPENED

As NCFAR embarks on its **20**TH **YEAR OF ADVOCACY AND EDUCATION**, the Board voted unanimously on October 29 to continue NCFAR into 2021 and beyond. The Board's decision was informed by nearly 6 months of evaluation by the Board 'Future of NCFAR' Task Force, established at the May 2020 Board meeting. That investigation included evaluation of feedback in response to 2 surveys.

Strategic planning is underway to sharpen the focus and effectiveness of NCFAR.
